**Consider the road conditions.**

**Stay within the speed limit and slow down on:**

- Narrow, winding roads
- Corners
- Gravels surfaces
- Road works

**Slow down and take care:**

- In rain, snow and ice
- In fog, which reduces visibility
- In wind, as gusts can make your vehicle less stable
- If there's sunstrike in the morning or evening
